
A WINDOW INTO 5/6 R

Another massive week in 5/6R. This week we have spoken regularly about resilience and our ability to use strategies to cope with difficult situations and then 'bounce back' from them. We have focused upon using these strategies inside and outside the classroom and celebrated moments when this has occurred.

We have demonstrated great resilience in adjusting to the NAPLAN timetable this week. Our four Grade 5 students have given their all to the tests and demonstrated great focus and effort. Our Grade 6 students have adjusted to numerous changes to classrooms and timetables, showing great responsibility and resilience.

In our Resilience Project lessons in the last 2 weeks we have reflected upon our own character strengths under the categories of Wisdom and Knowledge, Courage, Humanity, Justice, Temperance and Transcendence. We discussed how it is ok to

self - reflect and acknowledge that we are strong in some areas and need to develop our abilities in others. This work culminated in our WordArt designs highlighting our own personal strengths.

School-wide Positive Behaviour



This week's SWPBS Value is Resilience.

Students have been working on their ability to bounce back when a problem occurs or something doesn't go to plan. We have been focusing on good strategies we can use to help us bounce back quickly, and make sure we are happy and healthy minded for longer.

Students have learnt about having a positive mindset, and being able to choose how to respond to a situation. For example, Bob didn't get to be in a group with his best mate. Bob could choose to be upset and refuse to work in the group, OR he could make the most out of the situation and work well in a group of people that he may get to know and end up liking.

Improving children's resilience helps them to deal with the adversities they experience throughout their lifetime. This skill can be fostered at home, when children experience a problem that tests this skill. Remind your child that they always have a choice in how they choose to respond, and praise them when they make that right choice.

The enrolment timeline and all the new rules are on our website.



Headlice

We have had several cases of headlice reported over the past few weeks. To contain the spread of the lice it is important that we are all very vigilant. We ask that you all check your child's hair regularly. If you detect eggs or lice please keep your child home until you have treated them and inform the school. Please read the following information and recommendations.

- ☐ Concentrate on the head—there is no evidence to suggest that you need to clean the house or classroom.
- □ No treatment kills all of the eggs so treatment must involve two applications seven days apart. The best practice is to physically remove all eggs after treatment.
- $\hfill \square$ If you are using lotions, apply the product to dry hair.
- $\hfill \square$ It is important to inspect all family members if one member has nits or lice.
- ☐ Only the pillowcase requires specific laundering; either wash it in hot water or dry it using a clothes dryer on the hot or warm setting.
- ☐ There is no product available that prevents head lice
- ☐ Tying long back can help prevent the spread of head lice
- ☐ Combs with long, rounded stainless steel teeth positioned very close together have been shown to be the most effective, however, any head lice comb can be used.
